#### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

These instructions should be read carefully and retained after installation by the end user for future reference and maintenance.

These instructions should be used to aid installation of the following product: LWBPIR

#### **SAFETY**

- This product must be installed in accordance with the latest edition of the IEE Wiring Regulations (BS7671) and current Building Regulations. If in any doubt, consult a gualified electrician
- · Please isolate mains prior to installation or maintenance
- Check the total load on the circuit (including when this product is fitted) does not exceed the rating of the circuit cable, fuse or circuit breaker
- Please note the IP (Ingress Protection) rating of this product when deciding the location for installation
- . Do not overload this accessory or subject it to conditions outside its rating
- · This product is Class II double insulated
- This product is IP20 rated

#### INSTALLATION

This product is designed for use with LWB range of luminaires

- Remove a 20mm knockout from one end of the luminaire. If using the emergency kit LWBEMKIT, it is recommended that the sensor be installed on the opposite end of the fitting in order not to obscure the emergency LED indicator
- Feed the sensor cable through the knockout and secure using the lockring provided
- Ensuring correct polarity is observed, carefully wire as shown in Fig. 1, using the 2-pole clamp connector provided




- This product is compatible with the emergency kit LWBEMKIT, but not compatible with an external 1-10V dimmer
- This product is supplied with a choice of two lenses which alter the maximum detection zone radius (see Fig. 2)



- See below for PIR sensor settings
- Switch on and check for correct operation
